Specific gravity (water=1) 1.01

Evaporation rate- As water

Solubility in water- Complete

Surface and Air Temperatures

Best results come from Shine Guard being applied directly to a freshly cleaned, already cooled surface. Extreme temperatures (below 50 above 95°F) should be avoided.

Preparation

Properly care for and clean the surface of any contaminants BEFORE applying any Shine Guard. After the surface has properly dried then begin to apply Shine Guard.

Pre- Testing

Always perform a small test area in an inconspicuous location before applying to the surface. Shine guard works best undiluted and applied directly to the surface.

Application instructions

Thoroughly clean the entire surface and allow time to dry completely. Then liberally apply Shine Guard to the surface and let sit for several seconds. Lightly buff in with a rag, work it around all cracks, crevasses, and imperfections in the surface to leave a nice even luster to all work areas.

Coverage Rates

Coverage rates will vary from 25-100 sqft per quart depending on surface porosity, texture and age of the material.

Spill or Leak Procedures

Dispose of empty containers according to federal, state and local requirements. Wear protective equipment while performing clean up operations.
